

STANDING ORDER

Having considered a request from the United States Trustee that bankruptcy case trustees in this district be exempted from web PACER fees, and it appearing that the Judicial Conference Advisory Notes to the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule approved by the Judicial Conference state that bankruptcy case trustees are an example of a group that may be exempted by the court from payment of the fees, and it appearing that in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to PACER information, substantial justification exists to exempt the Chapter 7 Panel Trustees and the Standing Trustees in Chapter 13 and Chapter 12 cases from the fees otherwise assessed for electronic public access to court data,

It is ORDERED that:

1. Effective August 15, 2002, the Chapter 7 Panel Trustees and the Standing Trustees in Chapter 13 and Chapter 12 cases serving the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee, in addition to the authorized representatives of such entities, are granted an exemption





from the payment of Web PACER fees for the sole purpose of accessing case information from the PACER system in furtherance of their official duties as trustees.


2. Any such trustee or authorized representative who accesses case information from the PACER system pursuant to this Order is presumed to be acting in furtherance of his or her official duties as trustee.


3. The Clerk of this Court shall cause this Order to be sent to the PACER Service Center in San Antonio, Texas.
