

**RESTRICTIONS UPON ENTRY INTO UNITED STATES
COURTHOUSES IN THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF TENNESSEE**

Please be advised that a Standing Order was entered on March 16, 2020, by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee providing as follows:

It is further ordered that the following persons shall not enter any United States Courthouse in the Eastern District of Tennessee: any person who has been in China, South Korea, Japan, Italy, Iran, and Europe within the past 14 days from the date of the entry of this Standing Order or from the date in which such person is seeking entry into the Courthouse; or persons who reside or have been in contact with someone who has been in one of the countries listed above within the past 14 days; or persons who have been asked to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, health agency or other healthcare provider; or persons who have been diagnosed with, or have had contact with, anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19; or persons experiencing fever, cough or shortness of breath. To ensure the implementation of this provision of this Standing Order, the United States Marshal, his Deputies, and the Court Security Officers are accordingly DIRECTED to appropriately screen any visitors entering the United States Courthouses in the Eastern District of Tennessee consistent with these visitor restrictions and shall deny entry to anyone attempting to enter in violation of this Order.
