GENERAL ORDER

On December 21, 2022, the court increased the flat fee award provided for in E.D. Tenn.

LBR 2016-1(b) to \$4,000. Upon further consideration, the court has determined that an

additional increase is appropriate.

Accordingly, effective November 1, 2023, E.D. Tenn. LBR 2016-1(b) shall be further

amended to increase the amount that an attorney for a debtor may request without the filing of an

itemized statement from an amount that does not exceed \$4,000, as provided in General Order

2022-04, to an amount that does not exceed \$4,500. Counsel should continue to apply those

considerations recited in E.D. Tenn. LBR 2016-1(b) in determining whether a request for the

maximum flat fee is appropriate in any case.
