GENERAL ORDER

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee will be upgrading its Case Management / Electronic Case Files system, known as CM/ECF, on February 23, 2024.

CM/ECF and PACER will be unavailable for filing or viewing documents from 10:00 AM ET on Friday, February 23, 2024, until 8:00 AM ET on Monday, February 26, 2024.

During this time, the Clerk's Office will be open but will be considered inaccessible as that term is used in Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(a)(3) for purposes of calculating deadlines.

During this period of inaccessibility, the requirement in E.D. Tenn. LBR 5005-4 for electronic filing will be suspended for time-sensitive filings such as petitions, filings nearing the statute of limitations deadline, requests for emergency relief, notices of appeal, and any other document not otherwise governed by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(a). Such filings may be: (1) brought in person to the Clerk's Office during business hours or (2) submitted by email to ECFMail@tneb.uscourts.gov and will be deemed filed as of the date received as reflected on the email. Any documents submitted via e-mail during this time will be entered on the docket by the Clerk's Office as soon as practical after CM/ECF is upgraded and operational.

Information will be posted on the court's website, www.tneb.uscourts.gov, notifying the public when CM/ECF is accessible.
