in person to the Clerk's Office during business hours or (2) submitted by email to

ECFMail@tneb.uscourts.gov and will be deemed filed as of the date received as reflected on the

email. Any documents submitted via e-mail during this time will be entered on the docket by the

Clerk's Office as soon as practical after CM/ECF is upgraded and operational.

Information will be posted on the court's website, www.tneb.uscourts.gov, notifying the

public when CM/ECF is accessible.
