For all chapter 11 cases, including, but not limited to sub chapter V cases, the debtor(s) is required to APPEAR BY PHONE at the meeting of creditors on the date and time set forth in the original hearing notice for the purpose of being examined under oath. Attendance BY PHONE by creditors at the meeting is welcomed, but not required. The meeting may be continued or adjourned from time to time by verbal notice at the meeting, without further written notice to the creditors.

Prior to the time set for the meeting of creditors, please dial **877-647-0236**. When prompted, please enter **1558052** as the participant code to enter the meeting. Parties should dial in at least five minutes prior to the start of the meeting. After you enter the participant code please do not select any other feature. Once connected, please mute your phone until the case is called and disconnect when notified it is completed.

Debtors are encouraged to contact their attorney prior to the meeting for more information.
